

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A DUI

Drivers convicted of misdemeanor or felony DUI's may receive:

Criminal Sanctions

- County jail or state prison
- Fine, penalty/assessment and restitution
- Vehicle Impoundment or forfeiture
- License restriction, suspension or revocation

Civil Liability

- Accident related law suits
- Attorney's Fees
- City Booking Fees

Miscellaneous Costs

- Loss of employment
- Time away from family and friends
- Time away from school
- Loss of job opportunities
- Your reputation

DUI (Misdemeanor)

1st Offense

Fine: \$1,200 - \$3,000

Jail: 48hrs - 6 mos

License: 90 days - 6 mos suspension

Treatment Program: 3-12 mos

2nd Offense

Fine: \$1,200 - \$3,000

Jail: 48hrs - 1 yr

License: 18 mos suspension

Treatment: 9 -18 mos

DUI (Felony)

1st Offense

Fine: \$1,200 - \$3,000

Jail: 180 days - 1 yr

Prison: 16 mos - 3 yrs

License: 1 yr revoked

Treatment: 30 mos min.

2nd Offense

Fine: \$1,200 - \$15,000

Jail: 180 days - 1 yr

Prison: 16 mos - 3 yrs

License: 3 yrs revoked

Treatment: 30 mos min.

3rd Offense

Fine: \$1,200 - \$15,000

Jail: min. 1 yr

Prison: 2 - 4 yrs

License: 5 yrs revoked

Treatment: 30 mos min.

4th Offense (felony)

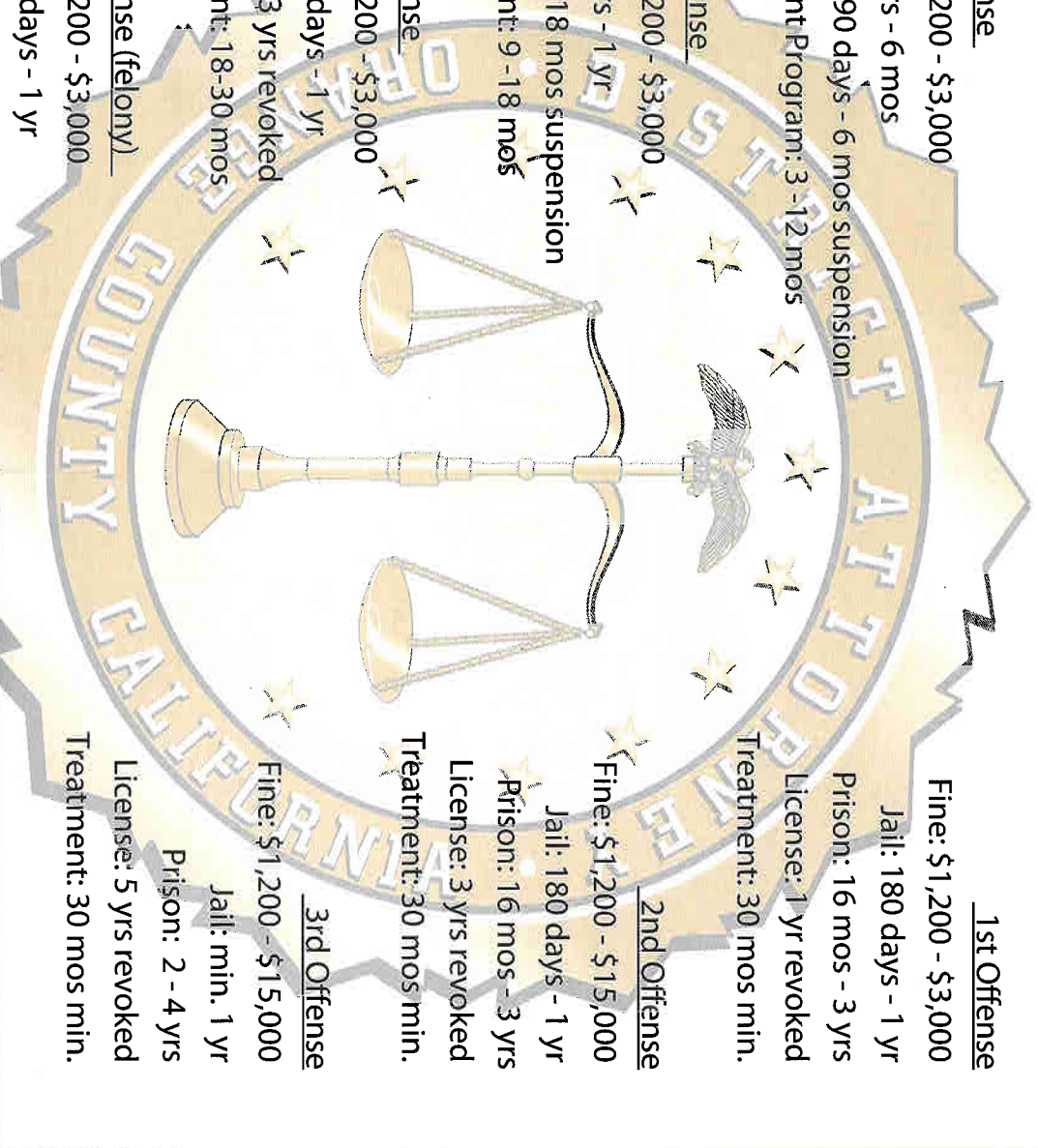
Fine: \$1,200 - \$3,000

Jail: 180 days - 1 yr

License: 4yr suspension & 18-30 mos

revoked

Treatment: 18-30 mos



IS YOUR CHOICE.

If you are under 21 and caught DUI...

On top of all the other penalties related to regular DUI cases:

- Your license may be suspended for an extra year.
- You may have to wait an extra year before you can apply for your drivers' license.
- You may have to attend a 1 year youthful alcohol and drug deterrent program

If you serve or purchase alcohol for someone under 21

- Parent: Civil and Criminal Sanctions
- Business: Loss of License and up to a \$3,000 fine
- Adult (21+): Criminal Sanctions, up to a \$3,000 fine, and 6 mos in jail

If you are driving while intoxicated with a minor

You may face child endangerment criminal charges or a penalty enhancement of 90 days in jail in addition to customary DUI charges.
